MODIFY COVID-19 TESTING HOURS
EFFECTIVE MARCH 29**

The Hawkins County Health Departments in Church Hill and Rogersville will be modifying COVID-19 testing hours effective Monday, March 29. Self-kit tests will be available for adults on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. Standard nasal swab testing will be available on Tuesday and Thursday from 10:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. Please see attached listing for hours. Local county health departments will continue to offer COVID-19 testing at no charge for anyone who wishes to be tested.

Test results may be available within 72 hours of arrival at the lab, depending on the volume of tests the testing lab receives. Information will be provided to participants at testing locations on what they can expect after being tested.
