**WASHINGTON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT
CHANGES COVID-19 VACCINE LOCATION
AND TESTING HOURS EFFECTIVE APRIL 26**

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. – The Washington County Health Department (WCHD) will change their COVID-19 vaccine location and COVID-19 testing hours effective Monday, April 26.

COVID-19 vaccinations will be transitioning from the Freedom Hall Civic Center to the **Washington County Health Department** beginning Monday, April 26. On Monday, April 26th through Wednesday, April 28th vaccination clinics (1st doses) will be held at the Washington County Health Department and the final two vaccination clinics (2nd doses) at the Freedom Hall site are scheduled Thursday, April 29th and Friday, April 30th. Starting May 3rd, all COVID testing and vaccinations will be held at the Washington County Health Department. The Washington County Health Department is located at 219 Princeton Road, Johnson City, TN 37601. COVID testing and vaccinations will be administered in the drive-through site at the back of the building. Please follow the red COVID-19 Testing signs to College Road and drive to the back of the health department.

April 28: Pfizer 1st Dose, 7:30 am-10:00 am, WCHD

April 30: Pfizer 2nd Dose, 9 am-1pm, Freedom Hall

Testing is available Monday-Friday from 1:30 p.m. until 2:30 p.m. Self-kit tests will be available for people age 18+ on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Self-test kits can be administered in the car at the health department or can be taken home to complete and mail. Drive through nasal swab testing will be available on Tuesday and Thursday at the health department for all ages. Local county health departments will continue to offer COVID-19 testing at no charge for anyone who wishes to be tested.
