COVID-19 VACCINE AND TESTING HOURS IN THE NORTHEAST REGION

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. – The Northeast Regional Health Office continues to offer free COVID-19 vaccines and COVID-10 testing at all eight local health departments in Carter, Greene, Hancock, Hawkins-Church Hill, Hawkins-Rogersville, Johnson, Unicoi and Washington Counties. VACCINE INFORMATION: The northeast region local health departments continue to offer COVID-19 vaccines Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Appointments are not required. Drive-through and walk-in options vary by location and masks are required to enter health department facilities.
